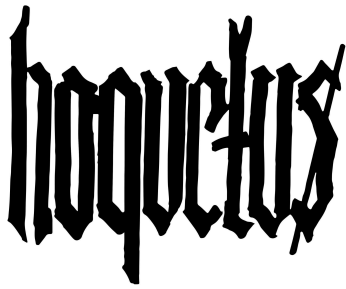

A spectacular rosé! A dry, aromatic, classically styled rosé. The Cabernet Franc vines are designated specifically for this wine and managed accordingly. Raspberry, strawberry, and ruby red grapefruit mingle with crushed rock, rose petals, and nasturtium in this complex, dry, grown up rosé. Bright acidity, medium body, and lovely fruit are the result of dedication to Rosé.

2020 Côte Bonneville Syrah

A great example of new world fruit with old world styling. This wine is balanced, with moderate alcohol and great depth and complexity. Cherry, boysenberry, marionberry, and cedar on the palate. This vintage impresses with its power, intense aromatics, and long finish..



Hoquetus Wine Co.

Walla Walla Valley, Washington

Owned by Robert Gomez and his wife Bri, Hoquetus is a tiny producer in the Walla Walla Valley producing wines of lightness and complexity. After beginning his wine journey in service, Robert moved into wine production; focusing on fresh, lower alcohol wines.

As co-owner and chief winemaker, Robert's faced his fair share of challenges; Covid, wildfires, heat waves, and economic uncertainty have made his wines all the more impressive. Perhaps most exciting is his focus on his customers; he's open in his views stating that his favourite part of the job is making and opening a bottle of wine that people find delicious and pleasurable!

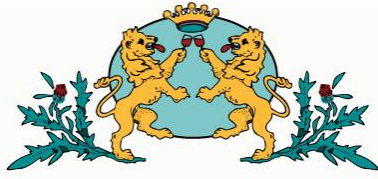

CAMERON

Cameron Winery

Dundee Hills, Oregon

Founded in 1984, Cameron winery is a family operation dedicated to producing high-quality, hand-crafted and sustainably farmed wines. They produce 3,000-4,000 cases annually and follow traditional burgundian practices such as only fermenting with indigenous yeasts from the vineyard, growing grapes without irrigation, and ageing wines in small oak cooperages for 18-20 months.

As co-founders of the Deep Roots Coalition, Cameron winery champions dry-farming and has for decades. Owner John Paul takes a hardline, believing that if you irrigate you shouldn't get to talk about terroir. By dry-farming they ensure the vine roots are deep, searching for water during years with less rainfall. As a result, the vines produce smaller clusters, with smaller berries that are more concentrated; which provide the backbone for Cameron's exceptional wines.

Cameron Abbey Ridge Chardonnay

Made with the precious Draper clone of Chardonnay, this wine is made from a very small block at Abbey Ridge. The grapevines are on a steep hillside of volcanic soil but you would swear from the resulting wine that a layer with calcium must lie underneath...it doesn't! And yet the wine is minerally and austere as one would expect from a classic Chablis.

Two years on the yeast in neutral barrels fill-out the mid-palate. And while the acidities from 2018 are notable, this particular wine stands out in that regard. It is the perfect accompaniment to every sort of seafood and crab season is upon us.

Over the past 20 years son Ross has established Cobb as a producer of exceptional, small batch pinot noir from Sonoma.

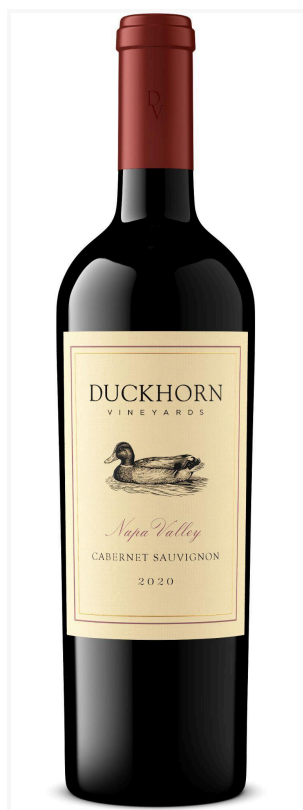

The wine has retained its effusive brightness and fresh acidity while continuing to acquire elevated nuance and bringing forward its many facets. Blue-fruit aromas, as well as pleasantly resinous qualities, accompany a fresh, cool note that rises to greet the nose.

The wine's lifted and profound dimension emanates outward from a centre of almost ethereal form. Although the fine-grained tannins introduce an element of restraint to this translucent radiance, the intrinsic nobility of this wine persists at each stage of its measured procession across the palate to the finish.

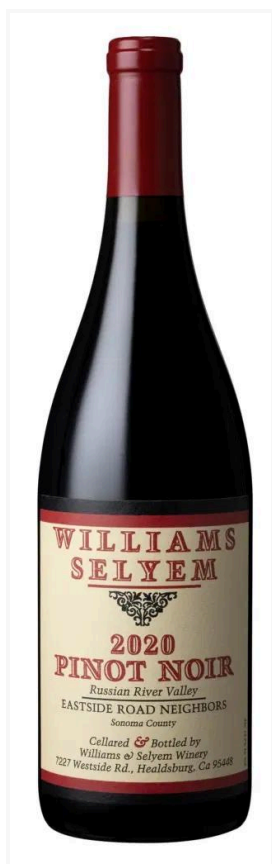
